七. Event Format :

(一) Men Elite: There are preliminaries and finals within 2 days (foreigner online and domestic on site). Riders whom have entered the finals will race the next day.

(二) Men Junior: They will compete online and on site for the finals without preliminaries race.

(三) Other categories will compete on site for the finals.

八. Results :

(一) Men Elite: The preliminaries race will be separated into 2 heats on 27 August, and select the top 12 riders of each heat to the final race.

(二) Guaranteed quotas: (1) The top 6 riders of the UCI World Cycling Esports championship.

(2) 8 Taiwan riders.

(三) Online route: Use the WhiizU software, please download the "WhiizU: World" app.

九. Questions about software and hardware: please contact the personal in official WhiizU website.

十. Insurance : All participants on site must obtain insurance for themselves. The organizer will also purchase insurance for participants on site, and the public third-party accident liability insurance.

十一. Prize : There will be in total around 28,000 USD prizes (the prize list will announce later).

十二. Awards Ceremony : (一) Medals will be presented to the top 3 riders of each event. Winner on site must wear jersey (or tidy sportswear) to attend the awards ceremony in person. Those who fail to do so will be fined and confiscated in accordance with the regulations of the organizer, and no compensation will be given.

(二) The international winners will award online.

十三. Regulations : The race base on the newest updated UCI cycling esports regulations and the regulation of the organizer. Please refer to the UCI cycling esports regulations at <https://ppt.cc/fwaxHx>.

十四. If the race encounters unpredictable interference from external forces, such as power failure, network interruptions, bluetooth interruptions, etc., the results will be determined by the commissaires panel.

十五. If there are any unexplained matters in this regulations. Then it can be amended at any time and reported it to the Sports Administration, MOE for approval, then publish.

十六. Participants have agreed and authorize the organizer "Chinese Taipei Cycling Association" to shoot, use, modify, retouch, and display the portraits (including photos and video images, hereinafter referred to as portraits), names, voices... etc. of the participants in this event, during broadcasting, all or part of the authorized content may be presented in various media channels or printing methods, and may be published, without further notification or consent of participants.
